

PROJECT: Due – 10 月 30 日

Learning Targets:

- I can introduce names, ages, birthdates and more of myself and other family members.
- I can use the Hiragana chart to read basic Japanese sentences in order to gather basic information about others.
- I can ask simple questions in order to obtain information about others.

Instructions:

1. You are going to introduce yourself and 2 family members verbally.
2. Family members may be real or fictional (see example videos below to clarify what fictional might mean).
3. Create a Power Point Presentation with 4 slides.
4. On each slide you will have the following (content such as name and age may be WRITTEN in English or Japanese, but MUST be said in Japanese):
Slide 1 – Yourself: a picture of the person (real or fictional), their name, age, and birthday.
Slide 2 – All family you will introduce: two pictures of your real family members or fictional family members (used to introduce everyone you will be talking about)
Slide 3 – Person 1: a picture of the first family member you will introduce, their name, age and birthday.
Slide 4 – Person 2: a picture of the first family member you will introduce, their name, age and birthday.
*as a bonus you may also include their hometown or grade level (if they are in school)
**names, ages, and birthdays will be written in English or using numbers (i.e. Mary, 14 y.o., 3/13)
5. In order to prepare for this presentation, you must choose which 2 family members you will use.

Final Steps:

1. Before submitting your recording, make sure you have practiced and are comfortable.
2. Open your PowerPoint with Pictures and Info.
3. Click on slide show at the top of the screen.
4. Click Record Slide Show (located in about the middle of the menu options).
5. Click the Red record button and wait for the 3 second countdown.
6. Record your own introduction ①.
7. Press the right arrow to go to the next slide.
8. Record which family members you will introduce ②.
9. Press the right arrow and then record Person 1 ③.
10. Press the right arrow and then record Person 2 ④.
11. Press the blue square to stop recording.
12. SAVE YOUR POWERPOINT.
13. Now turn in your PowerPoint to Teams Assignments.
